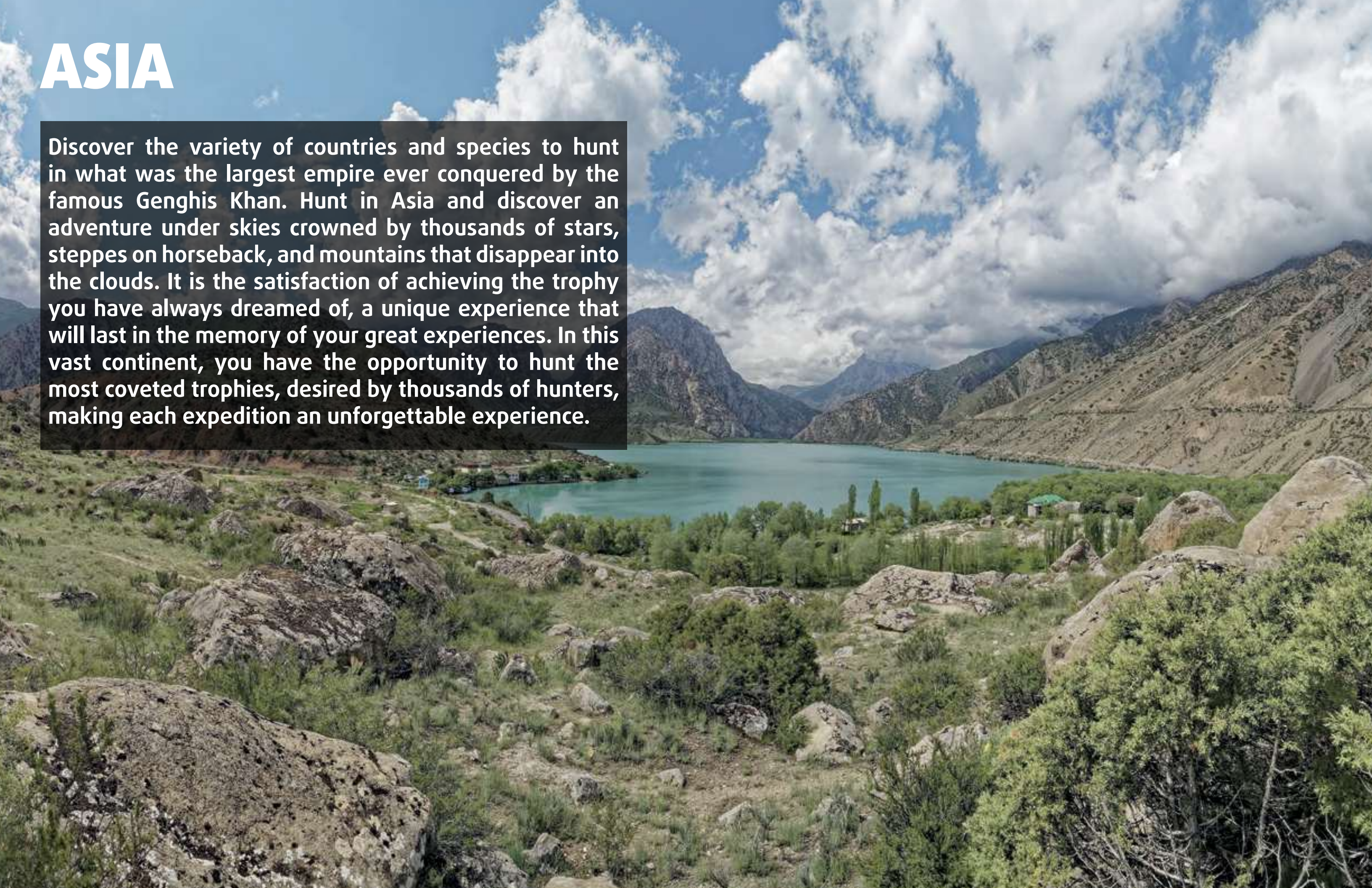

BECEITE IBEX

The Beceite Ibex, a prominent subspecies of the wild goat found throughout the Iberian Peninsula, thrives in the Puertos de Tortosa-Beceite region, home to one of Spain's largest ibex colonies.

Distinguished by their distinctive, laterally expanding horns reminiscent of airplane wings, these ibex males weigh up to 110 kilograms (242 pounds) and stand at 80 centimeters (31 inches) in height, with lengths reaching five feet. Notably, males feature a distinctive goatee beneath their chin, setting them apart from other ibex species in Spain.

GREDOS IBEX

Famous for being the biggest of the four different Spanish ibexes. The Gredos Ibex, is distinguished by its dark coat and formidable size, boasts some of the largest antlers among ibex species. Found alongside Beceite ibex, it possesses impressive horns that are big, ringed, and shaped like a lyre, with a rugged surface that speaks to the ruggedness of its mountainous habitat. The growth of these horns is a testament to the age and experience of the animal, adding one ring each year and serving as a striking symbol of maturity and strength in the wild.

RONDA IBEX

The Spanish Ibex of Ronda is distributed across southern Spain, in the province of Málaga. Morphologically it is the smallest of the four different types of ibex which are differentiated in our country. The horns grow upwards in a V shape and then backward with a spiral twist of just 90 degrees. While this is the typical shape of the horn of the Ronda ibex, other formations may be found in this region, even within the same herd.

SOUTHEASTERN IBEX

The Sierra Nevada or Southeastern ibex, dating back to the Pliocene Era, is a resilient species with origins traced to Central Asia's caprinidae.

Found across the Eastern side of Andalusia in Granada, Almeria, and Jaen provinces, these ibex feature thick, rough horns that curve backward in semicircles, distinguishing them from deer. Unlike deer, they retain their horns throughout their lives, with growth rings indicating age. Their unique hooves allow them to navigate vertical rocky walls effortlessly, even in winter when they seek refuge in lower areas.

BALEAREAN BOC

Originating from Mallorca's Balearic Island, the Balearan Wild Goat, or Balearan Boc, dates back to 2030 BC and stands out among Mediterranean goats. With a reddish coat, black cross on its back, and distinct black beard, it's easily recognizable. Male goats sport open, horizontally spiraled horns forming a "V" shape, reaching up to 100 cm in spread, while females have shorter, straight horns. These features reflect the species' sexual dimorphism and make it an emblematic part of Mallorca's fauna.

AODAD SHEEP

The Aoudad Sheep, or arruí, hails from the rugged Sahara and Western North Africa and inhabits Spain's southeastern mountains. This resilient species has short hair, except for its tail and a shaggy "beard" on its throat and front legs. Reddish or sandy brown with a lighter underbelly, both males and females have horns—females' are smaller, while males' are thicker, curving backward and growing throughout their lives.

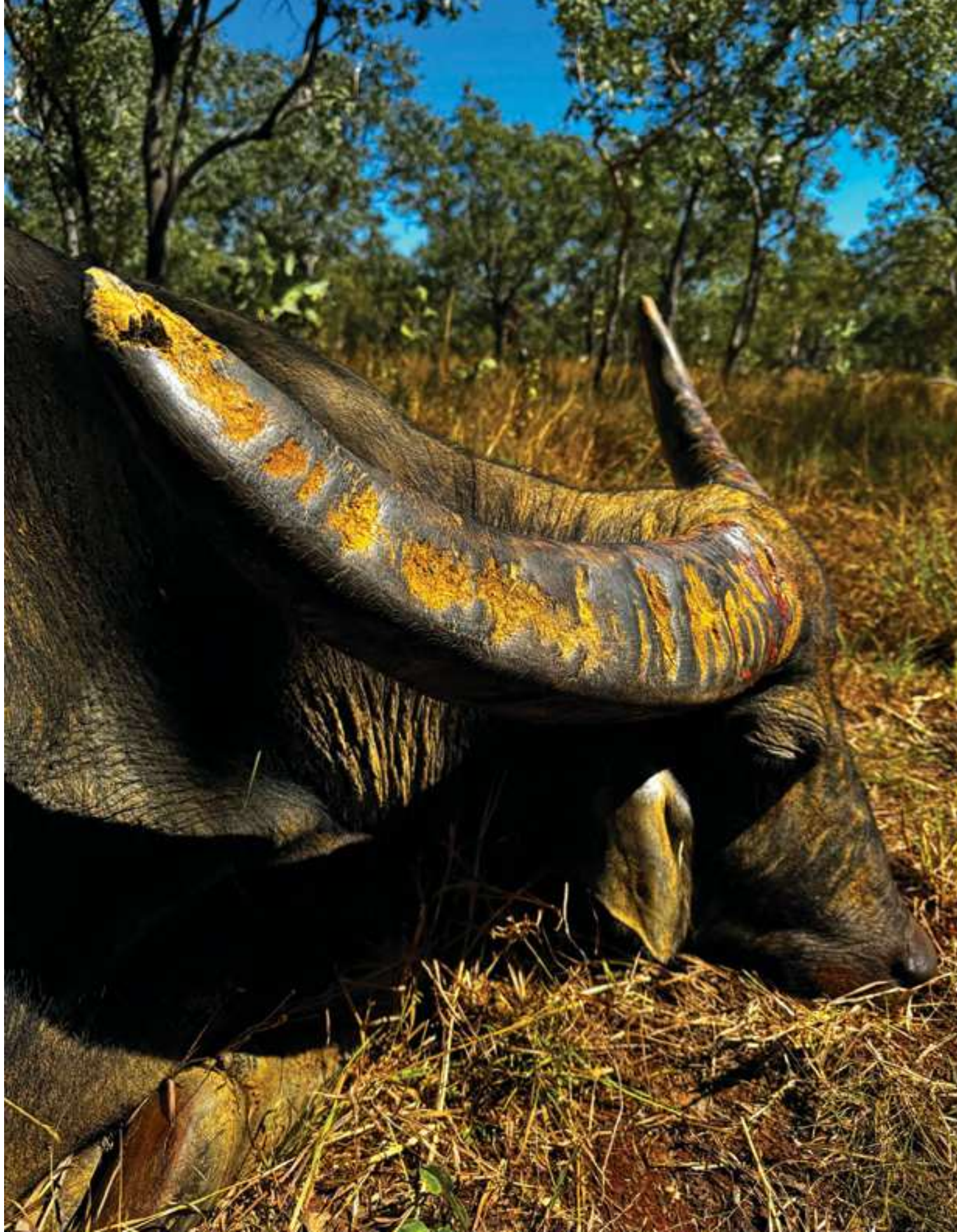
