Roger McCosker (NV) writes:

We met Antonio & Mercedes Teruel of IBER Hunting – Spain last year at the GSCO Slam Quest Convention. They were new exhibitors, and I found them to be very qualified, with over 30 years of guiding/outfitting in Spain.

I signed up to hunt both the Cantabrian and Pyrenean chamois while touring some of the most gorgeous historic mountain regions of Spain. The hunting itself was fun and exhilarating with lots of hiking/climbing. Antonio is a very good man, organized and holds excellent relationships with the locals in the mountain ranges we hunted. We enjoyed the rural setting, the food, lodging, historic villages, local people, etc.

These were my sixth and seventh chamois species, and my 15th and 16th Capra species. I highly recommend IBER Hunting – Spain.

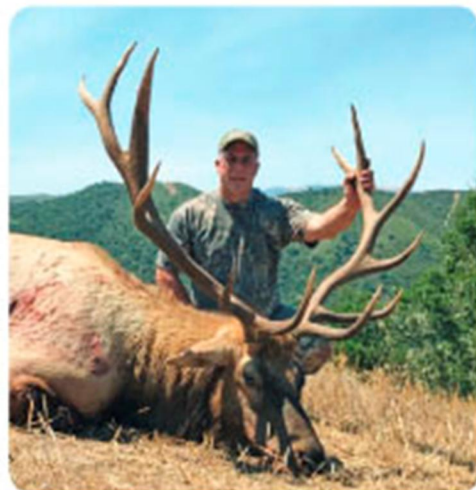

and the other came in at 305 7/8.

The following month Bill traveled to Newfoundland in pursuit of woodland caribou with **Red Indian Lake Outfitters**, taking a bull scoring 288 1/8 SCI:

It was great being able to help another hunter harvest his first caribou. I saw a giant bull on the last day of the hunt, but unfortunately the tags were already filled. This was an outstanding outfitter.

Bill's Tule elk came in July 2017 with **Gerry & Aaron Vanoli** and it had an SCI score of 295 7/8, and in September 2017 he traveled to Kansas, taking a whitetail scoring 167 3/8 with his muzzleloader.

Mark Pickering (NM) had a successful hunt in Mongolia for Altay ibex in August 2017, and soon thereafter filed the following report:

*After the fifth U-turn in the middle of the dark Mongolian desert, I decided it was time to wake up our handler and interpreter from **Mongol Safaris**, Naranbat, and tell him that I thought we were lost. We had left the motel at 3 am for the two-hour drive to the airport to catch*
